THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF VARIOUS ROADS IN NETTLEDEN, BERKHAMSTED AND NORTHCHURCH) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is given that Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from using the following lengths of roads ("the Roads"):-

1. that length of Nettleden Road, Nettleden from its junction with Pipers Hill south eastwards and southwards for a distance of approximately 250m.

An alternative route will be via Nettleden Road, Hudnall Lane, B440 (Dagnall Road/Leighton Buzzard Road) and Nettleden Road.

2. that length of Charles Street, Berkhamsted from its junction with A416 Kings Road north westwards to its junction with Cross Oak Road, a distance of approximately 500m.

An alternative route will be via A416 Kings Road, A4251 High Street and Cross Oak Road.

3. that length of Darrs Lane, Northchurch from its junction with A4251 High Street south eastwards and south westwards to its junction with Shootersway, a distance of approximately 640m.

An alternative route will be via A4251 High Street, Durrants Lane and Shootersway.

The Order is needed because works are proposed to be executed on or near the Roads.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 12 May 2025 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Roads.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
